May is Here

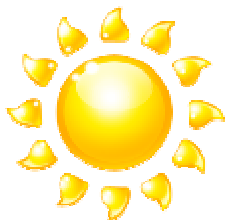
(Tune: Frere Jacques)

You are My Sunshine

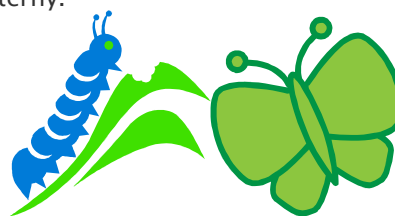
(Tune: You are my Sunshine)

(Start by holding up five fingers)

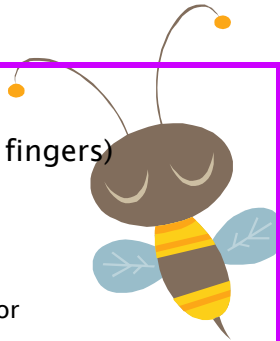
Five buzzing bees
